Insurance Coverage and Verification

Caris works to make molecular profiling accessible and our teams are available to help patients navigate the insurance and billing process. Although molecular profiling is typically reimbursed by most insurance providers for eligible patients, coverage and patient responsibility varies by each patient's individual insurance plan and the tests and/or services performed.

- 1. Caris performs the services ordered and deemed medically necessary by the ordering physician regardless of network provider status.
- 2. Caris coordinates prior authorizations and claim submissions directly with the insurance company.
- 3. If coverage is denied, Caris appeals the decision on behalf of the patient.

As part of the insurance process, patients may receive an **Explanation of Benefits (EOB), but an EOB is NOT a bill**. If you have any questions about an EOB or an invoice from Caris, please contact us.

Financial Assistance

For patients who have an out-of-pocket cost and are uninsured or cannot afford molecular profiling, Caris offers financial assistance programs to help with out-of-pocket costs for patients who meet eligibility requirements.

Broad Insurance Coverage

- More than 90 health plans cover Caris testing for qualifying patients, including Medicare, Medicare Advantage, Humana and multiple Blue Cross Blue Shield plans
- Qualifying Medicare/Medicaid patients have no out-of-pocket costs for next-generation sequencing tests
- For patients with an out-ofpocket requirement (co-pay, co-insurance, deductibles, etc.), the majority are responsible for less than \$200 for Caris testing

*Calculation includes patients with Medicare, Medicare Advantage, Medicaid, Managed Medicaid, and commercial insurance for the Next-Generation Sequencing (NGS) component only. Patient cost-sharing amounts, including deductibles and copays, will vary by plan and coverage type. Only the patient's insurance provider can confirm if and how each component of the Caris test will be covered. The NGS data cited are based on historical patient billing data from 05/2023 - 05/2024. Rates of coverage vary by state and region. Exceptions for coverage may apply. Additional IHC orders may require patient cost-sharing. Caris encourages patients contact their insurance provider with questions about test coverage.
